The May 1992 meeting of the AAC will be held at the Bradley Observatory on the Agnes Scott campus on May 15<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 p.m.

By the time you read this, Astronomy Day at Fernbank Science Center will have become history, so one segment of the May meeting will be devoted to reporting to the membership about that activity. Another segment will be devoted to AAC business that involves the membership: The Nominating Committee report. In addition, there are several subjects that need to be presented to the Club, including the one below.

The AAC is receiving an increasing number of requests for public viewing appearances and educational assistance. Volunteer efforts at local observatories are also solicited. This leads to the suggestion that we establish a position of 'public observing coordinator.' We can call it what we want, but the need is apparently there.
